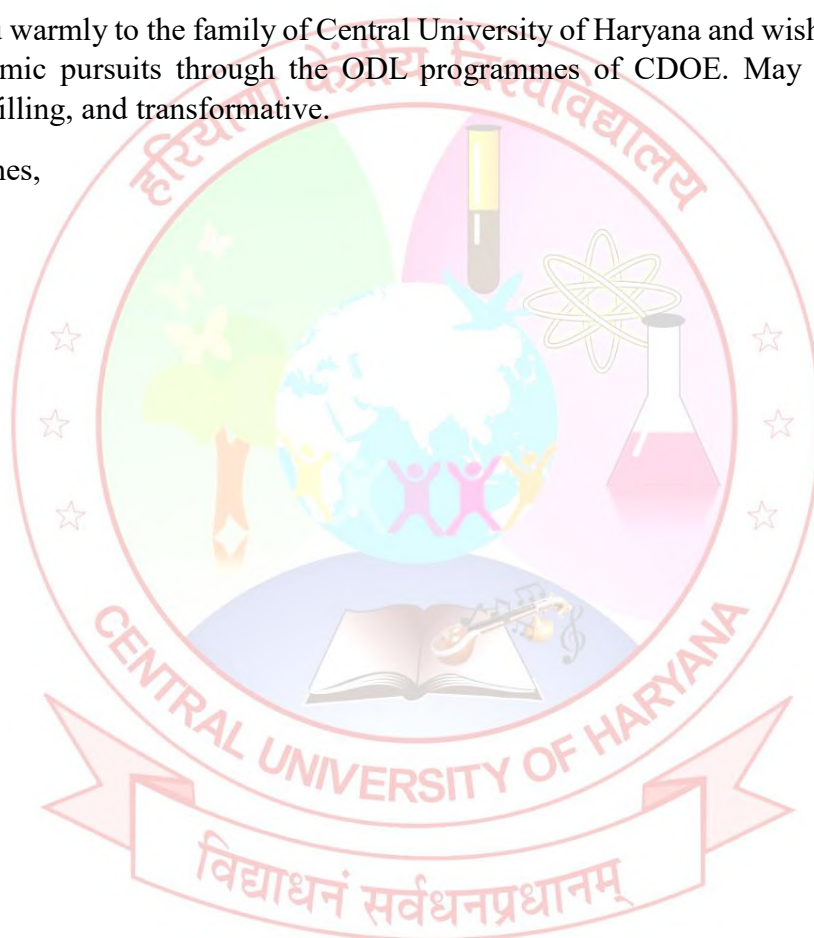
combine conceptual understanding with practical exposure, thereby equipping learners for careers in diverse fields.

Procedure to Apply for ODL Programmes of CUH

1. Visit the Samarth Portal

- Open <https://cuhcdoeadm.samarth.edu.in>.

2. New Registration

- Click on *New Registration*.
- Enter your basic details (name, email ID, mobile number, password).
- Verify through OTP sent to your email/mobile.

3. Login

- Use your registered email/mobile and password to log in.

4. Fill the Application Form

- Provide personal details (name, date of birth, category, address, etc.).
- Enter academic qualifications.
- Select the desired programme (M.A. Hindi, M.A. Journalism & Mass Communication, or M. Com).

5. Create Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID

- The portal will prompt you to generate an **ABC ID** (as per UGC mandate).
- You will be redirected to the **DigiLocker/ABC portal**.
- Log in using Aadhaar-linked mobile number.
- Generate your **12-digit ABC ID** and link it with your application.

6. Create DEB ID

- As per UGC-DEB requirement, learners must have a **DEB ID**.
- The Samarth portal guides you to the DEB registration link.
- Enter your basic details, Aadhaar number, and academic information.
- Generate and link the DEB ID with your application form.

7. Upload Documents

- Recent passport-size photograph.
- Scanned signature.
- Certificates/mark sheets of qualifying examinations.
- Category/other certificates (if applicable).

8. Pay Application Fee

- Make payment through the online payment gateway (Net banking/Debit card/Credit card/UPI).
- Save/download the fee receipt.

9. Final Submission

- Review all entered details carefully.
- Ensure **ABC ID and DEB ID are linked**.
- Click *Final Submit*.
- Download/print the submitted application form for future reference.

10. Check Admission Status

- Login regularly to the Samarth portal for merit list updates and admission notifications.

11. Confirm Admission

- If selected, pay the programme fee within the prescribed timeline.
- Upload/verify documents as instructed by CUH.

12. Commence Learning

- Once admission is confirmed, access Self-Learning Materials (SLMs), online resources, and student support services offered by the **Centre for Distance & Online Education, CUH**.

Evaluation Scheme: As notified for each programme by CUH/CDOE (may include internal assessments and end-term examinations as per ODL regulations).

- Internal Assessment-30%
- End Semester Evaluation- 70%

Examinations: Conducted as per the University's examination schedule/centres notified for the session.

Results: Declared on the official University portal as per the academic calendar.

Award of Degree: Upon successful completion of programme requirements in accordance with CUH ordinances and UGC-DEB guidelines.

1. *Who can apply?* — Graduates from any recognized University (programme-wise) as per eligibility.
2. *Are programmes approved?* — CDOE offers ODL programmes under UGC-DEB regulations as notified.
3. *How long is each programme?* — Minimum 2 Years (4 semesters); Maximum 4 Years
4. *How do I pay fees?* — Online via the Samarth portal during application/semester registration.
5. *Where are syllabi and past papers?* — Available on the CDOE website under Academics → Programme / Previous Question Papers.
6. *How are exams conducted?* — As per University's examination schedule/centres notified for each session.
7. *Is there any age limit?* — As per University/UGC norms; generally, no upper age limit for ODL PG admissions.
