In view of the Academic Calendar issued by AICTE and Key Dates issued by the HSTES, it is notified for information to all concerned that Online applications from eligible candidates (eligibility as per the prospectus - 2026 of HSTES) are invited for filling up vacant / leftover seats for admission in **B.Tech. 1st Year, Design 1st year and B.Tech. LEET programme** by paying registration fees of Rs. 1000/- for General Category including KM, TFW and EWS and Rs. 700/-for all reserved categories of Haryana (SC/ SC-D/ BC-A/BC-B/ PH/ FF/ ESM/Girls etc.).

Instructions for Institute Level Counseling:-

1. The candidates who have not previously registered for Institute Level Physical Counseling will also be allowed to participate in the spot round final counseling by paying the requisite Regn. Fee on the spot.
2. In case of B.Tech. Admissions, the candidates without JEE main Rank/OCET-2026 Rank will be considered on the basis of merit of qualifying exam only after exhausting the merit list of JEE Main (Rank)/OCET-2026 Rank holders' candidates.
3. **The eligibility for B.Design is 12th pass having atleast 45% marks (40% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in any stream.**
4. The registration fee of Rs. 1000/- for General Category including KM, TFW & EWS category and Rs. 700/- for All Reserved Categories of Haryana (SC/SCD/BC/PH/FF/ESM/Girls) for B. Tech./Design programme shall be deposited by the candidate online through Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking/UPI by using online payment gateway during filling the online application form available on the university website. The Online Registration Fee once paid by the candidate shall not be refunded (full or partial) under any circumstances. There is no involvement from the university in the service fees charged by the bank when paying registration fees with a debit or credit card or through any other payment channel.
5. The candidate should fill the JEE Main Rank (CRL Rank) – for B.Tech. 1st Year and OCET-2026 Rank (for B.Tech. LEET) carefully while submitting the application form. The **provisional merit list** shall be prepared strictly on the basis of the data filled by the candidates while filling their online application forms.
6. Candidates who may have filled the online application form and **paid the requisite application fee**, but **do not find their name in the merit list**, may still report as per counselling schedule during the attendance slot as per advertisement for marking attendance. Such candidates must bring:
 - **Proof of online application submission, and**
 - **Proof of successful payment of the application fee.**
7. Candidates who **failed to deposit the application fee** during the online application process due to any technical issue are **allowed to participate in counseling subject to submission of counseling fee at the time of reporting.**
8. All reporting candidates **must bring one set of Photocopies** of the required documents. The **original documents** are required for verification only. **The candidates are requested to bring a print-out of Application Form alongwith Fee submission receipt to participate in Institute Level physical counseling.**
9. The candidates who shall apply for EWS category shall also be eligible for AIOC (Gen. Cat.).
10. Students are directed to visit University website from time to time to get the latest updates regarding vacant seats position and other instructions.
11. The candidate must read HSTES Admission Brochure 2026-27 carefully for eligibility conditions also available on the University website.
12. **The candidates are required to pay the university admission fee of Rs. 50405/- (For TFW Rs. 42405/- and for SC candidates with income below Rs. 2.5 lakh Rs. 3,000/-) online after verification of the documents at the time of reporting. The payment shall be made through online mode (Debit/Credits Cards/Net Banking/UPI).**

13. After submission of admission fees, the candidate must report to the online admission committee for final admission and collect their provisional admission slip from the online admission committee before leaving the admission spot. In case of non-collection of admission slip by the candidate, University will not be responsible for cancellation of the admission at any stage.
14. The candidate who had not deposited his/her counseling fees earlier to the HSTES, needs to pay the HSTES counseling fees in the account of the University and the counseling fee collected by the University will be transferred to the HSTES account after the last date of admission.
- 15. As per the HSTES guidelines the last date for full fee refund (after deducting 1000/- processing fee) will be considered 31.07.2026.**
16. Any type of corrigendum/addendum/amendments/notices/updation etc. related to this advertisement shall be uploaded on the University Website i.e. <https://dcrustmadm.samarth.edu.in/> . Hence, candidates are suggested to visit the University website from time to time.

7. Haryana Residence Certificate is required to be submit by those candidates who have not passed their qualifying exam (10+2) from Haryana but claiming the HOGC as per **Annexure-II**.
8. PPP (Parivar Pehchan Patra for candidates who belongs to Haryana).

9. Divyang Certificate as per **Annexure-III** should be verified from PPP database
10. Schedule caste Certificate (SC) should be verified from PPP database.
11. Deprived Schedule caste Certificate (SC-D) should be verified from PPP database.
12. Backward Class certificate (BC-A, BC-B) should be verified from PPP database.
The parents of BC candidates (Block A&B) for benefit of reservation for their ward shall have to verify their annual family income verified from their PPPID during applying online to the effect that they does not fall under the creamy layer at the time of admission as per notification No. 40/13/2024-1SW dated 16 July, 2024 or as per their BC Category Certificate issued after 16 July, 2024.
13. Income Certificate of backward Class should be verified from PPP database.
14. Annual Parental Income from all sources (in case of TFW quota candidates) should be verified from PPP database.

15. Income & Asset Certificate (EWS) as per **Annexure-XI** and income (below Rs. 8 lakh) should be verified from PPP database.

NOTE: For all the reserved category, annual income & other details of the candidates from Haryana is to be verified from their PPP-ID for the purpose of admission, at the time of institute level counseling as per "Parivar Pehchan Patra Act-2021". All specific categories other than not available at PPP-ID portal (like KM, EWS) may be verified physically as per instructions given in Admission Brochure for B.Tech. 2026-27.
