


Eligibility Criteria for B.Tech Lateral Entry:

- a. The candidate must be an Indian Citizen and a Permanent Resident of Assam (With a valid PRC of Assam issued by competent authority).
- b. Candidates must have a Recognized Diploma in the relevant branch of Minimum of 3 years duration from any Polytechnic Institution of Assam.
- c. Candidate must secure a minimum of 45% (40% in case of reserved category) marks in the Polytechnic course.
 1. Reserved category includes (OBC/MOBC) NCL/ SC/ST(P)/ST(H).
 - i. In case of CGPA the % will be calculated by multiplying with conversion factor of the board / Institute/ University/ Council
 - ii. For the students who has passed from State Council of Technical Education (SCTE), Assam must secure a CGPA of minimum 4.94 for Unreserved category and minimum CGPA 4.39 for reserved category.

Note: 1. The conversion fraction from CGPA to Percentage in 9.125 for State Council of Technical Education (SCTE), Assam.

2. Candidates must submit their (OBC/MOBC) NCL / EWS certificate on the date of reporting. Failure to do will result in the cancellation of their seat for that counselling round. Furthermore, they will be considered as Unreserved category and candidates will be considered for the next round.

- d. The candidate must have a valid Rank in the Entrance Examination (JLEE_2026) for admission.
- e. The candidate must possess a good moral character.
- f. Candidates appearing in their final semester examination may also apply but they must have to produce their original Grade report/ Marksheet of the Diploma programme on the day of admission.
