Allocation to the hostel for the new students will be made from **21-07-2026 (02:00 PM) to 31-07-2026 (05:30 PM)** through the **Online Hostel Management System (OHMS)**, which can be accessed through <https://ohms.gbu.ac.in>

- Students need to create their login credentials and sign in to OHMS (Online Hostel Management System). After this the students can choose the room of his/her choice and get it allocated.
- Please note that all hostel allotment will be made through OHMS only.

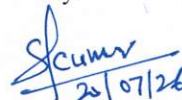

Key Details:

1. **Allotment Date:** The online allotment will begin on **21/07/2026 (02:00 PM)** and will continue up to **31/07/2026 (05:30 PM)**.
2. **Eligibility:** All newly admitted students (Academic Session 2026–27) are eligible for online hostel allotment.
3. **Accessing the System:**
 - a. Visit the University Hostels Official Website: <https://ohms.gbu.ac.in>
 - b. Navigate to Register/Login Section.
 - c. Register yourself using Enrollment Number (mentioned in admission letter) and other required details.
Allotment will be done on first come first serve basis.
4. **Allotment Procedure:**
 - a. Pay your Academic, Hostel, Mess and Common Fees (Prefer Online Mode) with minimum amount (As per Admission Brochure).
 - b. Login to the OHMS System using Enrollment Number and created password.
 - c. Book your hostel room and select your preferences for room sharing (in case of girls only).
 - d. There are limited numbers of single-seater rooms for newly admitted first-year female students and requests for the same will be approved only on a first-come, first-served basis. Requests for single-seater upgradation can be raised from the OHMS Portal. After subsequent approval and subject to availability, students can pay the remaining fees from the **"CSMS Portal"** for single-seater occupancy and book their rooms respectively.
 - e. After successful booking, download the Hostel Intimation Slip and respective forms (Form-A, Form-B, Undertaking: Anti-Ragging, Undertaking: General Rules and Regulations, Medical Information) from your dashboard.
 - f. Take the printouts of all forms mentioned above. Submission of all these forms, along with the **Hostel fee payment slip, two passport-size photographs of the students, two passport-size photographs each of the father, mother and guardian, and a copy of the Aadhar Card**, is mandatory at the time of hostel possession. Failure of which will lead to hostel allotment cancellation.
 - g. Fill all starred fields manually and duly sign all forms (signature of parent/guardian also required).
 - h. Report to the hostel on **05/08/2026 or 06/08/2026** along with duly signed forms for final document verification and take possession of your room.
 - i. A room once allotted online is non-transferable.
 - j. You should take possession of your room latest by **07/08/2026**; otherwise, the allotted room shall stand cancelled.

Please ensure that you complete the allotment process within the given timeline to secure your hostel accommodation. We are excited to have you on the campus and hope you have an enjoyable stay at Gautam Buddha University.
