IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Students must report with original documents and self-attested xerox copies for verification purpose.**
- **For UG Program:** Students who have cleared all the papers of their previous qualifying examination/degree will be considered. Candidate is required to produce the proof of the minimum qualification at the time of the counseling.
- **For PG Program:** Candidates appearing for their final qualifying examination may also apply. However, they must complete all eligibility requirements (theory, practical, viva-voce, etc.) and submit their **final result by September 30, 2026**. Non-compliance will result in automatic cancellation of admission. (refer admission brochure 2026-27, general Instructions 10.iii.b page no.56).
