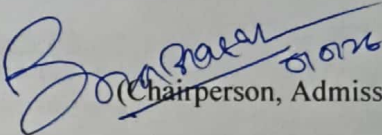
- I. Students must report with original documents for verification purpose along with one set of all self-attested Xerox copies.
- II. **For UG Program:** Students who have cleared all the papers of their previous qualifying examination/degree will be considered. Candidate is required to produce the proof of the minimum qualification at the time of the counseling.
- III. **For PG Program:** Candidates appearing for their final qualifying examination may also apply. However, they must complete all eligibility requirements (theory, practical, viva-voce, etc.) and submit their **final result by September 30, 2026**. Non-compliance will result in automatic cancellation of admission. (refer admission brochure 2026-27, general Instructions 10.iii.b page no.56).
- IV. The candidate must accept the offer of acceptance on the email shared by admission office and deposit an amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) online. (for more details about program and fee, refer to the Admission Brochure 2026-27).
