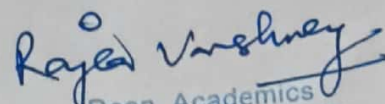
Relaxation in Eligibility criteria for; as under

1. B.Sc. (Hons.) Forensic Science
2. B.Sc. (Biotechnology) Hons. / Hons. With research
3. Master in Computer Applications

The eligibility criteria for admission in **B.Sc. (Hons.) Forensic Science, B.Sc. (Biotechnology) Hons. / Hons. With research and Master in Computer Applications** programmes have been relaxed by the Competent of the GBU with effect from the current academic session (2026-27). The relaxed criteria is now as follows:

B.Sc. (Hons.) (Forensic Science)	Passed 10+2 examination in Science stream securing minimum 55% in aggregate marks with minimum 60% marks in Chemistry (50% for reserved category along with 55% marks in Chemistry) or its equivalent grade.
B.Sc. (Biotechnology) Hons. / Hons. With research	Passed 10+2 examination in with PCB securing minimum 55% marks in aggregate along with minimum 55% marks in Chemistry and 55% in Biology for PCB students (50% for reserved category along with 50% marks in Chemistry and 50% marks in Biology) or its equivalent grade.
Master in Computer Applications	Passed and graduation degree (e.g.: B.E. / B.Tech./ B.Sc. / B.Com. / B.A. / B.Voc. / BCA etc.) preferably with mathematics at 10+2 level or at Graduation level Obtained at least 50% marks (45% marks in case of candidates belonging to reserved category) in the qualifying examination. (for students having no Mathematics background compulsory bridge course will be framed by the respective University / Institution and additional bridge courses related to computer subjects as per the norms of the concerned University).

All other terms and conditions in the Admission Brochure shall remain unchanged.


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
