

Important Guidelines for Candidates applying to M.A./M.Sc. Programmes

- All candidates seeking admission in the MA/MSc programmes must submit their applications online at the website <https://nsutadm.samarth.edu.in>
- Candidate must have a valid email id and a valid mobile phone number which will be verified using the OTP at the time of registration. For all later communications, candidates will be contacted through this email id and mobile phone number only.
- After successful registration candidates will be required to fill in all personal and academic details and have to upload PDF files of all credentials, as applicable for each category, while completing the profile section. (see public notice named “Supporting documents upload”)
- After completing the profile section candidates have to apply for the specific programme by navigating to “Apply for a Programme”.
- Candidates have to carefully fill the details of CUET PG score, registration number etc. in “National Level Admission Test (NLAT) Details”.
- A registration fee of Rs. 1500/- has to be paid at the time of submitting the Online Application Form. The payment has to be made in online mode. The registration fee is non-refundable and no claim whatsoever will be entertained in this regard.
- Candidates are advised to keep high-quality scanned copies of necessary documents ready before starting the online application process.
- Candidates should see the Eligibility Criteria section of the information brochure to check the eligibility for the programmes in terms of discipline of UG degree, minimum percentage in UG and CUET score.
- In case the student’s result in UG is available as a CGPA, then the same may be converted to percentage. Please see the Eligibility Criteria section of the brochure for details of minimum percentage.
- Candidate should provide complete information in the Online Application Form and should not hide any information. University may reject the application, at any stage, if any discrepancy is found in the given information. Further, incomplete forms are liable to be rejected without any further information.
- Candidates are advised to check the website <https://nsutadm.samarth.edu.in> regularly for updates related to registration and further stages of admission

Last date of registration is 30th June, 2026.

However, candidates are advised not to wait until the last date for submitting applications. Please complete your application process well in advance to avoid last-minute technical issues, delays, payment failures or other inconvenience. Apply early and ensure a smooth process.
