

Submission of Request for Withdrawal of Admission from M.Tech Programmes

All candidates admitted to the M.Tech Programmes for the Academic Session 2026–27 who wish to withdraw their admission are hereby informed that they are required to submit their request through the prescribed Google Form only.

Candidates are advised to carefully fill in all the required details in the Google Form and upload the necessary documents, if applicable.

It may be noted that the processing of admission withdrawal and refund of fee, if any, shall be carried out strictly in accordance with the University rules/guidelines and applicable refund policy (see next page).

The Google Form for submission of withdrawal request is available on the homepage of admission portal (<https://nsutadm.samarth.edu.in/>) and can be found under ‘Other Important Links’ at the bottom of the homepage.

Candidates are advised to submit their requests within the stipulated timeline. Requests submitted through any other mode may not be entertained.

The form should be filled in only using the e-mail id which was used by the candidate for registering for the M.Tech. admission process.

If a candidate submits this form, then he/she forfeits the seat allocated to him/her. It is an irreversible process as the seat will be allocated to another candidate.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.

Withdrawal Policy

The policy for the remittance and refund of fee, if a candidate chooses to withdraw admission from the program he/she has enrolled in, will be as per university norms.

For Regular Round of Admission

If a candidate withdraws admission from the seat allocated to him/her during a regular round of admission (*i.e.* from 17.06.2026 to 20.07.2026), then the procedure of refund of fees will be as given in Table 7.

Table 7. Procedure for withdrawal.

S. No.	Date of Withdrawal	Percentage of Refund of Admission Fee	Procedure
1.	On or before 06-07-26	100%	The candidate will have to fill an online form. The candidate will then have two options as follows. Option-1: The candidate may come to the university and collect his/her demand draft on 07.07.2026 (Tuesday). Option-2: The university will encash the demand draft submitted by the candidate and transfer the refund amount to the account of the candidate at the end of the admission season.
2.	07.07.2026 (Monday) to 21.07.2025 (Tuesday)	90%	The candidate will have to fill an online form. The university will encash the demand draft submitted by the candidate and transfer the refund amount to the account of the candidate at the end of the admission season.
3.	22.07.2026 (Tuesday) to 05.08.2026 (Wednesday)	80%	Same as above.
4.	06.08.2026 (Thursday) to 21.08.2026 (Friday)	50%	Same as above.
5.	22.08.2026 (Saturday) or later	0%	N.A.

For Spot Round of Admission

If a candidate withdraws admission from the seat allocated to him/her during spot round of admission, then the full annual fee deposited during the spot round of admission shall be forfeited, and no refund shall be admissible.
