

Notice Regarding Re-opening of Registration for M.Tech. Admission 2026-27

- Fresh registration for the last regular round of counselling for M.Tech. admission 2026-27 is made available from 02.07.2026 to 18.07.2026. **The last regular round of counselling will be held on 20.07.2026 and 21.07.2026 for filling the seats which are still vacant.** Candidates are advised to check latest vacant seat matrix on admission portal (<https://nsutadm.samarth.edu.in/>) time to time before registration/physical reporting.
- Candidates who have already registered in previous rounds of counselling need not register again and may physically report directly on 20.07.2026 (GATE qualified candidates) and 21.07.2026 (candidates appeared in written test held on 19.06.2026).
- Candidates who have not registered earlier and now wish to take part in the last regular round of counselling may register themselves on the admission portal now and apply for the M.Tech programme of their choice. **It is advised that candidates should carefully check the details of eligibility criteria, seat matrix, reservation policy and step-by-step registration process in the information brochure (page no. 6 to 15). The information brochure is available on the admission portal (<https://nsutadm.samarth.edu.in/>) in 'prospectus' section.** It is also advised that the candidates refrain from making multiple registrations/submission of forms for different courses/branches. The exercise of course/branch preferences (choice filling) shall be undertaken and considered during the candidate's physical reporting for counselling, subject to fulfillment of the prescribed eligibility criteria and availability of seats in the respective branches/programmes at the time of counselling. **Candidates are, therefore, advised not to submit multiple forms and pay the registration fee of Rs. 1500/- only once and not make multiple payments.**
- Non-GATE candidates who register now or registered earlier but did not appear at the written test held on 19.06.2026 will be required to appear for written test on 21.07.2026 at 10:30 am. The syllabus of written test may be found on page no. 32 of information brochure.
