Important Note:

1. All seats becoming vacant due to withdrawal till 19.07.2026 will be offered to candidates in this round. The details of vacant seat matrix will be uploaded to admission portal on evening of 19.07.2026.
2. Reserved category seats remaining vacant (in case no candidate of that category attends this round) will be converted as per seat conversion rule (see page no. 11 of information brochure) during this round.
3. Candidates who have already been allotted seats may change their branch if seats are available.
4. Candidates who have already registered in previous rounds need not register again for this round.
5. Candidates who have not registered in previous rounds need to register for this round (registration is open till 18.07.2026 11:55 pm)
6. Non-GATE candidates who have not appeared to the written test held on 19.06.2026 and all newly registered candidates under non-GATE category will require to appear for written test on 21.07.2026 at 10:30 am. The syllabus of written test may be found on page no. 32 of the information brochure.

Candidates should bring the originals and one set of self-attested photocopies of the documents in List-A and List-B.

- Marks sheet and certificate of class 10th board examination.
- Marks sheet and certificate of class 12th board examination.
- Marks sheet and certificate of B.Tech. (in case the result of the 8th semester of B.Tech. is not available at the time of filling in the Online Application Form, percentage till 7th semester will be considered.)
- Rule for conversion of CGPA into percentage of university where the candidate has studied B.Tech. (if applicable).
- GATE score card (if applicable).
- Caste/ category certificate (if applicable) issued by one of the following authorities of competent jurisdiction:
 - District Magistrate/ Additional District Magistrate/ Deputy Collector/ 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/ Commissioner City Magistrate (not below the rank of 1st class Stipendiary Magistrate)/ Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant.
 - Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
 - Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
 - Administrator/ Secretary to Administration/ Development Officer (Lakshadweep and Minicoy Islands).

- Certificate of Physical Disability (if applicable) issued by Chief Medical Officer of a district/ civil surgeon or any government hospital authorized to issue such certificates under the provisions of PWD Act 1995.
- Annual income / combined family income certificate, applicable for EWS category only
